  - Management tools, cost-benefit-analysis, innovative strategies for financing
- **B. Sustainably Managing Mining Sites** 
  - Best practices, prevention and implementing the precautionary principle
  - Managing heavy metal contamination (large accidents and liabilities)
- C. Challenges and solutions in Implementing the UN Minamata Convention
- D. New Policy objectives and responses in Contaminated Land Management
  - UN Sustainable Development Goals
  - Climate Change Mitgation

If you are interested in volunteering, please submit your nomination latest until 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019.

Support and advise to the Organising Team regarding selecting presentations and establishing the final program will be provided by the Programme Committee.

The acceptance of proposals will be confirmed to experts within 3 weeks until 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2019.
