To participate in the conference as a speaker, fill out an **application for participation before December 13, 2020** on the conference website in the section "Participate" http://www.dokuchaevskie.ru/participate?lang=en

Participants can indicate their wishes for the selection of the section, but the final distribution of participants by sections will be carried out by the organizing committee. The program of the conference will be specified after the end of the abstract submission and sent to the registered participants.

Abstracts should be uploaded via the form located the link to at http://www.dokuchaevskie.ru/abstract-submission?lang=en before December 30, 2020. Together with the submission of abstracts, you must upload the Agreement to the publication of abstracts, drawn up according to the presented example in the abstract submission form. Agreement must be printed, signed, scanned and downloaded in jpeg or pdf format. To upload abstracts, you will need to create a Google account if you do not have one. To do this, click the link https://accounts.google.com/?hl=en.

The file with the abstract should be named by the first author last name. The file with agreement should be named «last name_agreement».

If you want to change the title of your abstract or include new co-authors after submission, follow the link sent to you on the email provided in your application form. You will receive the letter with the link automatically after the submission of your application.

Registration fee. A registration fee is 20\$ (early registration – before 11.01.2021) or 25\$ (late registration – after 11.01.2021)

The method of payment will be indicated in the informational letter N_2 2

Information about the acceptance of abstracts will be indicated in the informational letter \mathbb{N}_{2} . The organizing committee has the right to select materials according to the topic of the conference.

Publication. All submitted and accepted abstracts will be published by the beginning of conference in an abstract book. The best papers will be published in a book "Materials for the study of Russian soils".

Paper requirements:

Papers should not be more than 2 pages long. Page size A5, the size of type is 12 pt, interval between lines is single, MS Office Word format (doc., docx), margins of page are 2 cm.

The *first line* is a title of paper (center alignment), *the second* – authors (center alignment), *the third* – country, city and university (center alignment), *the fourth* – e-mail (center alignment)

The text of the abstracts is separated by one line and begins with an indent of 1 cm (width alignment)

Last line – full name, academic degree, post of supervisor
