As part of this, the JRC is happy to announce the **first Young Soil Researchers Forum**. We care about ideas from the new generation of scientists!

We plan a **2.5-hours meeting** with parallel sessions (up to six) targeting specific themes with 10 presentations (8 min + 2 min questions) and 30-minutes final discussion.

Session themes will be assigned based on abstract submissions. All aspects of soil research are welcome (soil biodiversity, erosion, pollution, nutrients, urban soils, compaction, etc.).
